WHO?

Anyone enrolled in Beginning Clothing STEAM 1, Clothing STEAM 2, Advanced Clothing STEAM 3, Recycled Clothing, Decorate Your Duds, Artistic Clothing, Buymanship and wearable Heritage Arts projects may model up to two garments or articles they have made for themselves.



Cloverbud 4-H Members

Cloverbud members may model in the Public Fashion Revue. They can participate in the interview/judging but they are still considered non-competitive. Complete the registration form and return it to the 4-H office by June 23, 2017.



Photographs

Shaylen will take pictures after you are judged. If you are modeling two outfits and want two photos, have the first photo taken in the outfit you will model last and second photo taken in the outfit you will model first. Photos are limited to one photo per unit modeled.



Awards

Unit champion & reserve champions will be selected in the Junior (ages 8-13) and Senior (ages 14-18) divisions where divisions merit a Champion award. A Junior Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected. A Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the senior division to represent Arapahoe County at the Colorado State Fair. Grand Champions will also receive Grand Champion awards. There will be specialty awards presented.



Evaluation of participant:

The judge will be looking at these areas:

Attitude:	a smile that radiates enthusiasm
Posture/poise:	at ease in walking & turning, walk tall- turn slowly
Outfit on 4-Her:	design suited to body type and appropriate use and age of 4-Her
Fabric or yarn:	choices suitable for garment, individual and occasion
Fit:	enough ease is allowed and garment is in harmony with body lines
Construction:	quality of work is visible from the outside, contributes to overall look of outfit
Grooming:	becoming hair-do, nails and make-up

The judging and public show is happening all that the same time this year.

Fashion Revue Checklist:

You will be evaluated on your total look, the entire outfit including accessories!

<u>Have you done the following?</u>	<u>Look in the mirror, what do you see?</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">* Clipped all threads?* Pressed all seams and darts carefully?* Finished seams that could ravel?* Are the sleeve caps smooth, no puckers or tucks?* Hooks, eyes and snaps are properly sewn where needed?* Facings are under stitched?Garment well pressed?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">* Hem even and stitched inconspicuously?* Pants/ shorts legs the same length?* Sleeve length the same?* Seams lie flat?* Linings don't show below hems?* Should fit? Shoulder pads properly placed?* Have you chosen suitable accessories?* Examples: jewelry, purse, jacket, etc.

You should be able to answer these questions with a "YES"!!

Remember, what you wear looks good when you smile and walk with confidence!!

What do I Have to Do Now?

1. **EMAIL** the registration form to Sflorez@arapahoegov.com by **Friday- June 23, 2017**. Late registrations are not accepted. Remember: register now even if your garment isn't completed yet!
2. **EMAIL** your script **by July 10th** to Shaylen Florez, Sflorez@arapahoegov.com

If you don't have email, please arrange with a friend that has email to send it for you. (This saves time for the volunteer 4-H narrators in re-typing your information for the fashion show script and it makes it easier to make last minute changes and edits. THANK YOU for using EMAIL!)

How to Write Your Script

Each participant must write the script to be read by our narrator while you model your garment the day of the Public Fashion Revue. A script of approximately 100 to 150 words will give you the right amount of time on the runway. Remember that if you plan to model two garments, you will need to write a script for each one. **Your script will be edited by the narration committee for the public style show.**

1. Tell us about yourself:

- * Tell us your name, years in 4-H, name of 4-H club, 4-H club projects, grade in school and name of school (or home school)
- * Describe the activity or event where you might wear your outfit
- * What sports, hobbies and activities do you enjoy?

2. Tell us about your garment:

- * What makes this garment so special? Is it the color or style? What drew you to this particular pattern of fabric?

Use the above information to put together your script. **Your script will be edited and changed to fit within the flow of the style show**, so just do your best getting the basic information down. If you can, try to tie into our theme: "Fairy Garden Fun".

Sample Script:

Sporting her stylish garment is Jane Clover, a 10 year old 5th grader at Washington Elementary School. Jane has been a member of the Saddle Fashion 4-H club for 3 years. She sewed her denim skirt for the unit 1 clothing project. The hardest part was the hand hem and she is most proud of the great color match she found for her shoes and top. She plans to wear this to church and western dances. Jane participates in other 4-H projects: dogs, foods, photography, and cake decorating. Her hobbies include: reading, swimming, and horseback riding.
